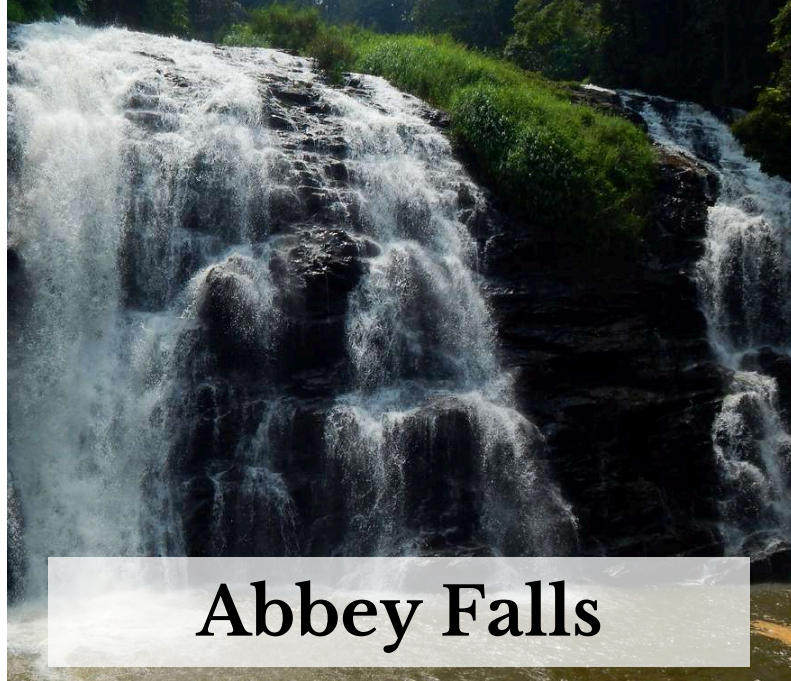
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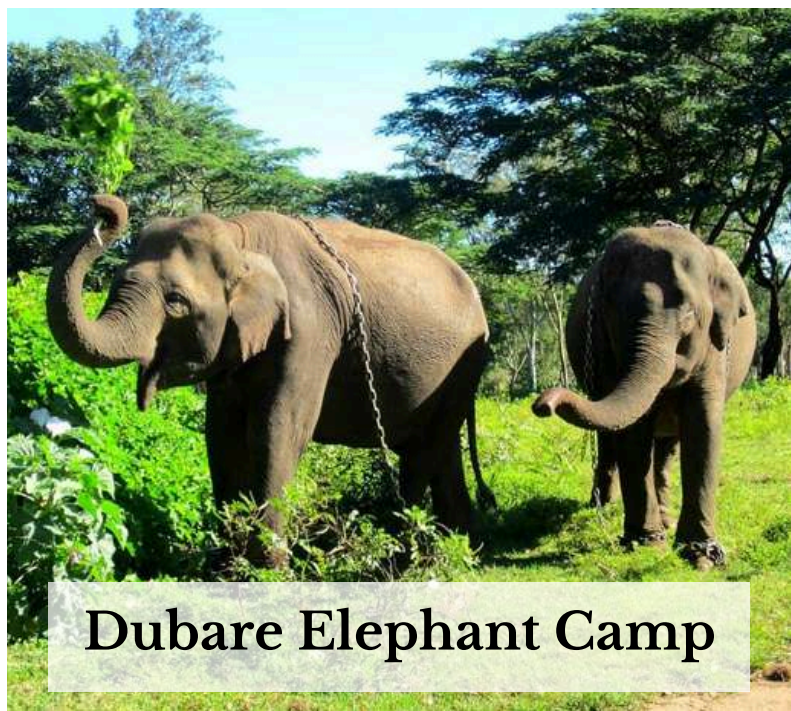

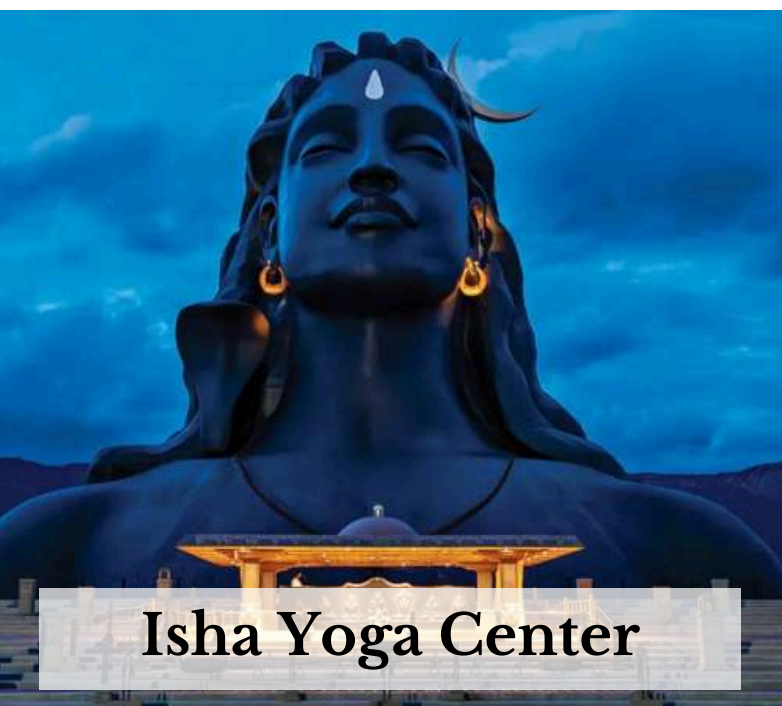

Tour Itinerary

Day 1 - Bangalore

Arrival at Bangalore airport/ railway station and proceed to the hotel. Bangalore is the capital city of Karnataka state it is well known as Garden city. Afternoon proceed for a half day city tour of Bangalore. Visit Lalbagh, Cubbon Park, ISKCON Temple, Vidhana Soudha and finally at Commercial Street for a bit of shopping. By evening return back to hotel and overnight stay at Bangalore.

Day 2 - Coorg

In the morning, after breakfast , check out the hotel and drive to Coorg - the "Scotland of Karnataka" nestled in the Western. On the way to Madikeri, visit Bylukuppe Tibetan Settlement and Kaveri Nisargadhama at Kushalanagar. On arrival check in to the hotel. After lunch, relax for some time and proceed for the sightseeing. Visit to Abbey Falls, one of the picturesque waterfalls of Karnataka situated amidst beautiful coffee estate. Evening visit to Omkareshwara Temple - a temple having both Islamic and Gothic style of architecture and Raja Seat- a seasonal garden of flowers and artificial fountains. Arrive at hotel and overnight stay at hotel.



Day 3 - Coorg

Morning breakfast and proceed for the sightseeing for full day covering Talacauveri - located in the picturesque location of Brahmagiri hills. Talacauvery is the origin of River Kaveri, a beautiful Talacauvery Temple built around it, and then visit to Bhagamandala. Bhagamandala is famous for the confluence of the three sacred rivers, Kaveri, Sujoyothi and Kanike. Visit to the temple dedicated to Bhagandeshwara (Lord Shiva). Return to the hotel for the lunch. After lunch, visit to Dubare Elephant camp, a forest camp on the banks of the River Kaveri where bathing and feeding the elephants are done. Dubare elephant camp in Coorg is the perfect destination to enjoy Elephant rides, bird watching and adventurous trekking. Arrive at hotel and overnight stay at hotel.



Day 4 - Coorg – Mysore

After breakfast proceed to Mysore on the way visit Srirangapatna which was the capital of King Hyder Ali and his son Tippu Sultan. By noon at Mysore and check in to the hotel. Afternoon visit Mysore Palace, one of the major attractions of Mysore. Then to Mysore Zoo where you can see some of the rare species of wildlife. Evening proceed to world famous Brindavan Gardens expanded over 150 acres. The musical fountain and light show adds attraction to the gardens. Return back to the hotel and overnight stay.

Day 5 - Mysore – Ooty

After breakfast check out hotel and proceed to Ooty passing through Bandipur. Check in at the hotel as you arrive in Ooty. Evening free for shopping and other activities and overnight stay at Ooty.



Day 6 - Ooty

After breakfast proceed for a site seeing tour of Ooty. Visit the Doddabeta Peak , Botanical garden, rose garden , Lake and Bat house. Overnight stay

Day 7 - Ooty

After breakfast proceed to Coimbatore visit, Isha Yoga Center, Kovai Kuttralam, Marutamalai Murugan Temple. Overnight Stay.

Day 8 - Coimbatore

Morning after breakfast check out hotel and proceed to Coimbatore . On arrival drop at airport/ railway station for onward journey.
